Ahmad Abu Bakr Touni joined Al Futtaim Group Real Estate (AFGRE) in October 2008 as Cairo Festival City's General Manger, for Design Management. Amongst his responsibilities, Touni is responsible for, developing a strategy for the procurement of projects, coordinating with the commercial management and development and operations divisions, managing and reporting on the statutory authority process, as well as ensuring the efficient use of investment funds.

Touni has over 28 years of diverse experience in managing and directing multidiscipline organizations and projects. Prior to AFGRE, Touni held the position of Vice President of Projects, for DAMAC Properties-Egypt, where he oversaw the process of project developments, audited the work of the project management team, and represented the company among local authorities. During his time at the company, Touni was involved in major project developments, including Gamsha Bay, Hyde Park, and Park Avenue.

Prior to his position with DAMAC Properties-Egypt, Touni worked as the Managing Director for Contrack International Inc. CII, the Facility Manager for Contrack FM International Ltd., the Chief Executive Officer for the Grata for Real Estate Development Inc., and the Managing Director, Construction Manager, Project Manager, and Site Engineer for Tab Construction Company Inc. In 1981, Touni worked as a Site Engineer and Project Engineer for the Al Muhairy General Contracting Company for two years.

Touni's community activities are extensive. He is a member of the Egyptian Engineers Syndicate (EES) and the Egyptian Architects Association (EAA).
